

## Contingency minute – June 5, 2020

**Change of cabinet:** Claudio Alvarado, former Subsecretary of Regional Development, assumes in Segpres, while Felipe Ward, who headed that ministry, assumes in Housing, replacing Cristián Monckeberg, who moves to Social Development. Sebastián Sichel is the new president of BancoEstado, with the task of increasing the speed of Covid loans. Monckeberg and Alvarado enter the political committee.

**CPI surprises in May and falls 0.1%:** it records a cumulative increase of 2.8% in 12 months and 1.3% up to 2020, according to the INE.

**Economic reactivation plan:** between US\$ 8 billion and US\$ 12 billion will have the fund for facing the crisis that is being discussed in the Senate Finance Committee. Priority would be given to income protection, employment subsidies and economic reactivation. The Ministries of the Interior and Finance have been asked to present measures to reactivate the economy. In addition, 13 unions will identify obstacles to investment.

**The government is incorporating a bill that proposes better financing options for big companies:** it is also improving the insurance market and making adjustments to the investment regime of the AFPs. The initiative passed to the Senate yesterday.

**Subtel forecasts an increase of more than 60% in data consumption:** the increase would be a consequence of the pandemic. During the first semester it increased 40%.

**CMF evaluates extending the period of flexibility of provisions:** In order to facilitate the rescheduling of clients. The Commission informed that the amount of non-Covid-19 loans rescheduled exceeds one million.

**Mineduc discards closing the school year:** It points out that schools should prepare for a gradual return of students and requests mayors to outline plans. Technical high schools would be the first to return. Association of Municipalities requests protocols and funding sources.

**Civil judges propose procedural changes:** to the Supreme Court regarding notifications and their timeliness. It is being evaluated to have them done so electronically.

**ProChile is repositioning itself:** it has cut its budget by 41% and will focus on exporting SMEs.

**Discussion regarding CAE credit condonation:** according to Clapes UC it would cost US\$ 8.4 billion. Students with the credit reach a million.

### International

<b>World Health Organization (WHO):</b>	6,287,771 infected (93,246 new cases) worldwide and a total of 379,941 deaths (3,621) in the last 24 hours.
<b>Johns Hopkins University<sup>1</sup></b>	6,663,729 infected in 188 countries, with 391,588 deaths. The United States is the country with the most confirmed cases (1,872,660), followed by Brazil (614,941) and Russia (449,256).

**Argentina extends the quarantine:** for three more weeks. It would complete 100 days of confinement.

**Peru extends the State of Emergency:** up to 90 days. Meanwhile, quarantine was extended until June 30.

**China authorizes international airlines to fly:** one flight per week.

**Researchers backed out of the study that had negative conclusions about hydroxychloric acid for combating Covid-19:** three of the four researchers backed out of the study because they could not access the data that used as a basis for the analysis.

**Unemployment in the US reached 13.3% in May:** less than the 20% expected in the market.

- 15:00: Chilean Association of Renewable Energies and Storage (Acera AG) holds annual "dinner" of Renewable Energies in digital format. The meeting is held over two days and the first is "Energy Regulation and Renewable Energies". The Minister of Energy participates.
